- 2. Proof of student loan (i.e., a copy of your needs assessment summary) must be submitted with your application. Failure to provide this will delay the processing of your application.
- 3. Please fill in all areas of the application form, including the financial questionnaire. **NOTE: Omissions will result in delays in considering your application.**
- 4. Completed bursary application forms are to be submitted to the Registrar's Office.
- 5. Any bursaries awarded will be applied directly to your student account.
- 6. If you withdraw from the university or your coursework falls below three half credits per term, your bursary will be pro-rated for the remainder of the academic year. Exceptions will be considered on an individual basis.


