\* Costs are in Canadian dollars and are subject to change. Students who are not Canadian citizens or permanent residents are required to pay the International Tuition Fee along with the International Health Plan.

International Tuition Fee: Undergraduate start prior to fall 2025 and current graduates - more than 9 billing hours - \$22,441/yr (\$11,220.50/term); Part time - \$748.03/billing hour (less than 9 billing hours).

International Tuition Fee - Guaranteed: Undergraduate (non professional) cohorts entering fall 2025 and later (program length plus 1 additional year) - \$35,842/yr (\$15,950/term)

International Tuition Fee - Guaranteed: Undergraduate (non professional) cohorts entering fall 2024 and later (program length plus 1 additional year) - \$33,814/yr (\$16,907/term)

International Tuition Fee - Guaranteed: Undergraduate (non professional) cohorts entering fall 2023 and later (program length plus 1 additional year) - \$31,900/yr (\$15,950/term)

International Health Plan Single Student: \$926.59/year & the summer full time fee is \$308.88.

\* King's Student Union Health and Dental Plan Fee stated is for 24/25 as the 25/26 is not known yet.

\* Students will be required to pay late fees and interest on account balances that are outstanding beyond the term due date.

\* Nova Scotia students may be eligible for the N.S. Student Bursary - up to \$1,283/yr.

\* The summer term due date for students taking undergraduate or graduate summer courses, is the first day of classes.

\*\* Assuming all electives are arts courses.

\*\*\* All electives taken at King's or Dalhousie are charged at the journalism program rate. The summer is an estimate only and assumes student is part time taking one half credit journalism course.

\*\*\*\* Assumes student takes their two electives in the winter term and that both are journalism courses.

\*\*\*\*\* If required, students cover travel, meal and accommodation costs themselves for program residencies, as these expenses are not covered by tuition.
