The Harrison McCain Scholarship/Bursaries are available annually to entering students attending university who have graduated from a high school in Canada. Each award has a program value of \$16,000 payable over a four-year course of study in the amount of \$4,000 per year. Criteria for the awards include a minimum 80% average in senior year of high school, financial need, leadership qualities, and a recognized initiative in funding their own education. The number of scholarship/bursaries available may vary from year to year. Renewal criteria to be met each year.
